

RECYCLING GUIDELINES

Effective 4/18/12

As a part of our continuing effort to improve the operation of the Transfer Station, to keep compliant with the DEP's requirements, and to shift more of the cost of solid waste disposal from the general taxpayer to those who actually produce the waste, the Board of Selectmen has adopted the following fee schedule for the disposal of non-household waste, effective March 17, 2009:

Air Conditioner	\$ 13.00
Bath Tub	\$ 6.00
Box Spring	\$ 5.00
Chairs (kitchen/wood)	\$ 2.00
Chairs (stuffed or recliner)	\$ 5.00
Computers (CPU or monitor)	\$ 5.00
Couch/Sofa/Loveseat (broken down to chair size)	\$ 10.00
Electronics (radio, TV, VCR, stereo components, sewing machine, etc)	\$ 5.00
Dehumidifier	\$ 13.00
Freezer/Refrigerator	\$ 20.00
Foam Rubber (packed in clear bags)	\$ 1.00
Garden Hose	\$ 1.00
Humidifier	\$ 5.00
Insulation (bagged in clear bags)	\$ 2.00
Lawn Furniture (PVC type)	\$ 2.00

Mattress	\$ 10.00
Rugs (wall to wall)	\$ 25.00
Rugs (room size)	\$ 15.00
Sheet Rock (one piece) up to	\$ 2.00
Sheet Rock (pick up truck load)	\$ 75.00
Shingles (pick up truck load)	\$ 75.00
Shower	\$ 6.00
Sink (non- metal)	\$ 5.00
Stoves - w/mercury (without are free)	\$ 10.00
Toilets	\$ 5.00
Vacuum Cleaners	\$ 3.00
Vinyl Siding (pick up truck load)	\$ 25.00
Waterbed	\$ 10.00
Wood (must be clean and free of glass, screens, etc.) single piece up to	\$ 2.00
Wood (pick up truck load)	\$ 75.00

PLEASE RECYCLE

PAPER:	Newspapers
DO - Deposit loosely all newspapers	DO NOT- tie newspapers with string, tape, wire or put in bags.
- Insets are acceptable	-Include papers that are over 90 days old or that are very wet
- Include telephone books	-Include paperback books with covers, junk mail, envelopes, personal mail

GLASS:	
DO - Recycle clear glass	DO NOT - Include window glass, light bulbs, mirrors, or ceramic
- Remove all caps and rings	- Leave food in container
- Remove all food waste	- Include returnables

CARDBOARD:	
DO - Flatten and remove all banding and strapping	DO NOT - Include cardboard with a waxy surface.
	- include cereal boxes or six pack containers
	- Include Oriental boxes
	- include Styrofoam packaging

TIN CANS:	
DO - Rinse	DO NOT - Leave food in container
- Place lids inside	

All items being deposited must be ready for deposit prior to arrival at the Searsport Transfer Station. This means removal of all unacceptable items attached to items being deposited including, but not limited to Freezer/Refrigerator doors, window glass from frames, screens from wood, and any other items that would contaminate the designated pile that the item is being deposited to.
